Dear Parent/Guardian

Re: **School Uniform and Trainers**

We appear to have a lot of children coming in to school in incorrect uniform and also wearing very brightly coloured trainers. I thought it might be a useful reminder to send out the uniform policy again so that you are confident that the uniform you are buying is the right one for school.

Please can I remind all families that trainers can only be worn when your child is coming to school in their PE kit. Trainers cannot be worn with regular uniform and if your child attends school in trainers on a non PE day they will be provided with a pair of pumps. If your child wishes to change into a pair of trainers to play out in at lunchtimes (to play football for example) that is fine but they need to change back into their school shoes before coming back into class.

With regards to the trainers that we expect to see in school these need to tie in with the school colours so either a plain white pair or a plain black or navy pair and not bright neon colours. I appreciate that some of you will have already purchased trainers for this year and they may not be plain and if that is the only pair that you have for PE so be it but please purchase a plain pair next time. If pupils do come into school in brightly coloured trainers and we have spare trainers in school then we may ask the pupil to use the spare trainers for that day.

I do not want anyone to spend additional money on new trainers but to purchase plain ones the next time you are renewing your child's PE kit. From the start of the next academic year in September I would expect that all children will have the correct type of trainers for PE.

If you have any problems with buying PE kit or uniform we do have some spare items in school so please either email the School Business Manager, Mrs. Smith, or ask at the office and we will try and find some suitable supplies for you.
